Likewise, in order to strengthen the exchange of knowledge with national and international researchers, our editorial policy seeks the participation of renowned researchers. For such purpose, in this latest issue we have the collaboration of authors attached to national institutions such as Universidad Militar Nueva Granada, Universidad de Cartagena and Unicolombo; and international ones like Universidad de la Habana in Cuba, and Universidad del Espiritu Santo in Guayaquil, Ecuador.

Confident that the fruits of collective work will enrich the academic debates and be valued by our readers, we hope that the impact factor of our articles matches the judgment of the arbitrators they were subjected to and the good criteria of the editorial board.
